The Indiana University School of Medicine Office of Gift Development is seeking a motivated, highly organized undergraduate or graduate student to serve as a project manager for the Indiana University Melvin and Bren Simon Cancer Center's "Miles for Myeloma" fundraising event.

For the past seven years, IU Simon Cancer Center oncologist Rafat Abonour has run and cycled from Indianapolis to a different city in Indiana to raise awareness about and funds for the research of myeloma, a rare blood cancer. Many of his patients serve on a planning committee to help organize the event, but a central project manager is needed for this growing event, which has raised more than \$1.75 million since 2005. The intern will have a highly flexible work schedule, including working some hours off-site if necessary, and will be charged with the following:

- Assisting patients and their families with developing personalized letters for their individual fundraising campaigns
- Meeting the ongoing needs of patients and donors by providing reports, writing thank-you letters, etc.
- Managing the patient volunteers who assist with the planning of Miles for Myeloma, including planning monthly committee meetings
- Interacting with various vendors and other professionals to plan and execute all aspects of the event
