

Tissue Collection Volunteer Opportunities

All volunteers need to have a good attitude and be willing to take direction. These are quantities for a one shift event. For a two shift event, these quantities will be doubled.

Donor Escort – coordinates when there are openings in phlebotomy and tissue exam rooms; escorts next available donor to open slots. <u>Need to be organized, outgoing and have a good sense of direction.</u> (35+ needed)

Check In/Check Out -- checks donors in and sends them on to the next step; checks donors out and provides them with post op instructions. <u>Must be friendly and organized</u>. This assignment is designated by KTB staff. Sign up for "donor escort" and express your interest in the comments area. (5 needed)

Journal Keeper – encourages donors to contribute to KTB journal about why they are participating. <u>Good for</u> <u>outgoing personalities with good mobility.</u> (2 needed)

Height & Weight – escorts donors to and from consenting area to height & weight station; records height & weight. <u>Must be able to write legibly</u>. (4 needed)

Specimen Runner – takes specimens from phlebotomy or exam room to the on-site lab for processing. Must observe universal precautions for handling bodily fluids (i.e., wearing gloves at all times). <u>This can be high school</u> students or others who have good mobility. (12 needed)

Computer/Questionnaire Assistant – assists any donors who require help completing the online questionnaire. <u>Must be comfortable with computers.</u> (10 needed)

Room Coordinator – coordinates the placement of donors in exam rooms. <u>Must be well organized and have</u> advanced knowledge of the flow of a collection event. (4 needed)

Consenter – <u>must have regulatory (CITI) training and approval to participate</u> (lay people can do this with the right training). Administers the Informed Consent to formalize participation in the Komen Tissue Bank's clinical trial. (12 needed).

Laboratory – processes tissue and blood samples in the on-site lab. <u>Must be familiar with universal precautions for</u> handling bodily fluids. Lay people can be trained. (12 needed)

Phlebotomy – draws blood from donors. Must be trained and proficient. (5 needed)

Surgeon Assistant – assists the Surgeons or Radiologists in the exam rooms. <u>Must be aware of sterile technique.</u> <u>Can be nurses, nursing students or others with similar training.</u> (25 needed)

Surgeon/Radiologist – takes the tissue samples using vacuum-assist biopsy device. <u>Must have regulatory training</u> and approval to participate (CITI). (6 needed)
